



KWIK TRIP HOLIDAY FACE-OFF

A BRIEF HISTORY

2022- Clarkson surprised many in capturing the 2022 Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off. The Golden Knights overcame a 3-0 deficit, led by a Mathieu Gosselin hat trick, to defeated No. 15 UMass 6-3 in the event's first semifinal game. In the nightcap, Jared Moe turned aside all 24 Lake Superior State shots he faced in leading Wisconsin to a 4-0 win. In the title game, Clarkson's Chris Klack scored the game's only first period goal and then the Knights (Anthony Romano) and Badgers (Cruz Lucius) exchanged second period goals before an open netter with two seconds left gave Clarkson a 3-1 win.

2021- Wisconsin needed extra time to win its two games in the inaugural Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off. The Badgers took their opener when Brock Caufield scored in overtime, giving Wisconsin a 3-2 win over Yale. In the title game against Providence, a shootout was needed to declare a champion and it wasn't until the sixth round when Zach Urdahl broke a 1-1 shootout tie to give the Badgers the crown. Providence advanced to the final with a 6-2 win over Bowling Green. The Falcons then beat Yale in the consolation game, 2-1.
