



Wisconsin, #2 Boston College, #4 Western Michigan, and Lake Superior State to play in the 2025 Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off

Teams will meet December 28-29 at Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee

PRINCETON, N.J. – The Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off returns to Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee with **Wisconsin, #2 Boston College, #4 Western Michigan, and Lake Superior State** comprising the fifth annual event on December 28 and 29, 2025.

Semifinal play will take place on Sunday, December 28 with the Championship game and third-place game on Monday, December 29. Matchups and times will be announced at a later date.

Wisconsin won the inaugural event in 2021, advanced to the title game of the 2022 tournament, and won again in 2023 and 2024. The Badgers have 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and six National Championships on their resume.

#2 Boston College has a record of 12-3-1 in the first half of the 2024-2025 campaign, spending the majority of the season as the #2 team in the country. The Eagles have 36 NCAA Tournament appearances (second all-time), 26 Frozen Four appearances, and five National Championships (latest in 2012).

#4 Western Michigan has been ranked in every poll throughout the 2024-2025 season, jumping to #4 in the December 30 poll. The Broncos are 13-4-1. The Broncos have 9 NCAA Tournament appearances.

Lake Superior State returns for their second Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off after competing in the 2022 event. They have 11 NCAA Tournament appearances and are five-time National Champions.

In the **2024 Kwik Trip Holiday Face-Off**, Wisconsin edged out UConn in an exciting third period, winning 4-3 to capture their third event title after shutting out Ferris State 8-0 in their semifinal matchup.
